1. Background

During the last few years the National Research Foundation (NRF) has embarked on a process designed to enhance and simplify the NRF administrative interface with Researchers, Students and Designated Authorities. This has been done by streamlining its application templates and its Call Opening process, in line with the forthcoming Research Support Strategies by the Department of Science and Innovation (DSI) and the NRF. These changes will create enhanced efficiency in receiving and processing applications and be more effective in prioritizing funding to best serve the NRF mandate.

2. Application Categories

As a result of the streamlining, the NRF will publish the One Call for Applications for funding in March 2022 (Review Period 1) and others later in Review Period 2 under the following categories. Refer to Appendix 1 for the Review Periods.

3. Cut-off dates and Review Periods

The NRF will accept applications for processing until the DA cut-off date for each Funding Opportunity as indicated in Appendix 1.

The **Applicant Cut-off Date** is reintroduced this year and applicants must submit their applications before or on this date. Applicants will not be able to create or submit applications after this cut-off date. They will be able to amend applications which were submitted by the Applicant Closing Date if/when the institutional Designated Authority opens the application for amendment.

Some institutions set their own internal closing dates and applicants should therefore ensure that **the institutional deadlines are strictly followed**.

Applications submitted by institutions after the DA Cut-off Date, will not be considered.

Institutional Cut-off Dates: Internal

The cut-off dates for submission of applications to institutions are dependent on the internal cut-off dates of individual institutions. Institutions may wish to set their own internal cut-off dates for submission of applications to their Researchers/Students, to ensure applications are not submitted late.

Applicants are **strongly advised** to adhere to the institutional cut-off dates so as NOT to miss the opportunity for their applications being submitted to the NRF for review.


4. How to Apply

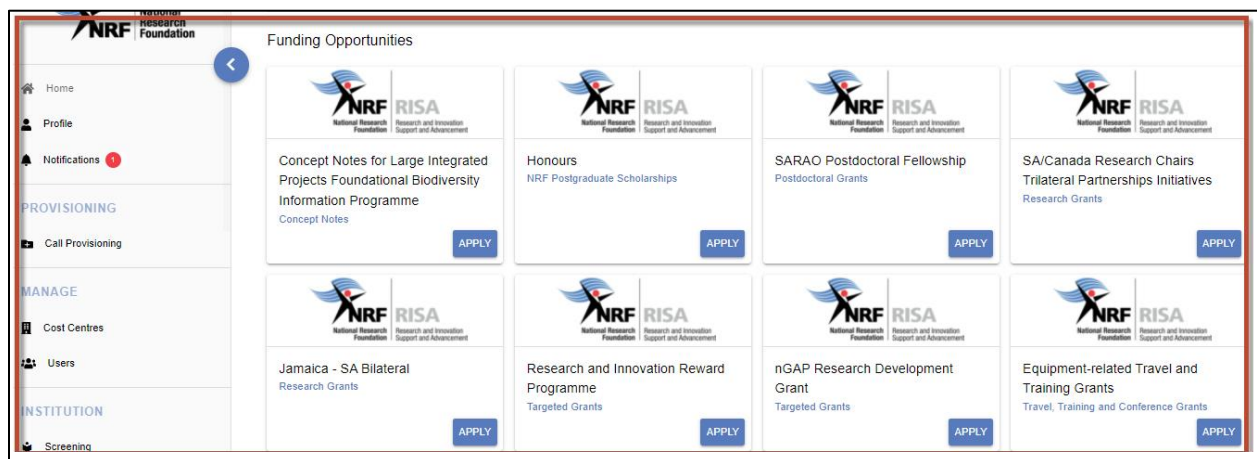
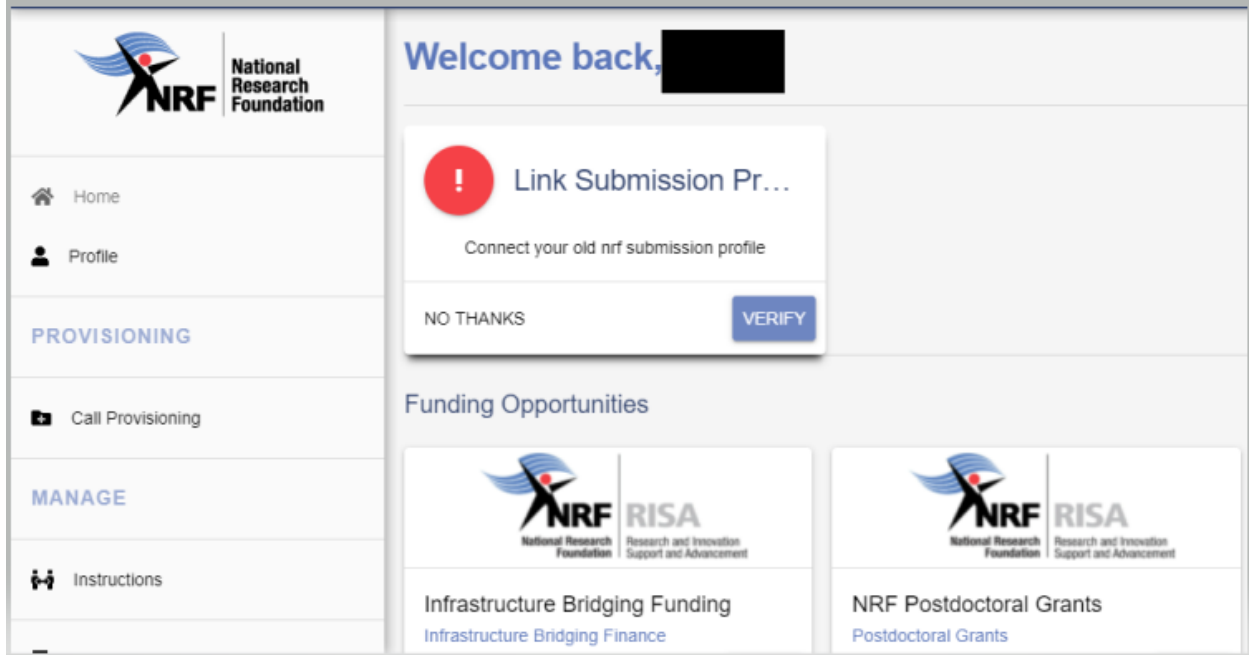

- **Remember** to 'Synch' your CV with the NRF Online Submission CV, should you have one, first.

- Complete all the compulsory sections of the application as well as the non-compulsory sections which are relevant to you.
- Attach all the required documents in PDF format.
- Submit the application on completion.
- Complete applications will go to the Research/Postgraduate Office of the applicant's institution for processing.

The following applications **will not** be considered for funding:

- Incomplete applications;
- Applications that do not meet the eligibility criteria as outlined in the call documents;
- Applications submitted outside the NRF Connect System, unless indicated otherwise;

- Applications submitted in hard copies; and/or
- Applications in a language other than English.

Only applications endorsed by the Research/Postgraduate Office at Higher Education Institutions, or their equivalent at declared NRF Recognised Research Institutions, as gazetted, will be accepted. Please contact the relevant Research/Postgraduate Offices, or equivalent, at your institution if you have any queries.

Instructions to Research/Postgraduate Officers (or equivalent)

Please ensure that you prepare adequately for the advertised cut-off dates.

Designated Authorities (DAs) are the gatekeepers of quality applications to safeguard the reputation of institutions in accessing funds. As such they should:

- Provide guidance and advice to potential applicants, researchers, grantholders and students in the choice of funding opportunities available to them;
- Review applications for completeness and correctness before submission to the NRF. This includes ensuring that all compulsory attachments are uploaded and are correct;
- Open applications for amendment if/when required and indicate where revisions are required;
- Ensure that applications meet all the Funding Opportunity eligibility criteria before submitting to the NRF.
- Decline applications that do not comply with the eligibility criteria and provide feedback to the applicant;

Please Note:

- Under no circumstance should DAs submit applications to the NRF if not all the eligibility criteria are met. This includes the correct attachments as required.
- For the Thuthuka funding opportunity, DAs are requested to enter the preferred Funding Track in the “Comments” block provided.

5. Evaluation of Applications

All applications received by the NRF are screened for eligibility and for compulsory documentation to be submitted with the application. Applications that are deemed not eligible or do not have **ALL** the required attachments will not be processed further.

Reviewing of most applications for funding will be through a one-stage or a two-stage process.

One-stage review is when specialist reviewers are asked to review applications virtually **OR** convene as a panel to share their reviews of the applications, score them, generate a collective outcome, and provide a recommendation to the NRF. This process therefore entails the panel engaging the applications directly, and not receive and deal with postal reviewer reports.

Two-stage review is when applications are sent to remote, specialist reviewers who submit review reports on the application. Thereafter, the review reports are primarily considered by a panel/committee in scoring and generating collective outcomes and recommendations.

6. Outcomes

After considering the recommendation from the review process, the NRF makes awards according to the recommendations, set criteria and objectives of the various funding opportunities, and funds available.
